

Job Description Summer Ministry Team 2012

The Summer Ministry Team is a group of approximately 4 people who travel across Canada providing ministry to ECCC churches and camps. It is a program intended to expose the team members to various church and camp ministries in a way that both gives the team opportunities to serve as well as receive discipleship.

Responsibilities

General

- Be friendly, patient, polite and courteous with church members, campers, staff and guests .
- Maintain daily prayer and quiet times for personal spiritual growth
- Attend all staff meetings, Bible studies and prayer times
- Regular check in with a designated mentor.
- Balance fun with responsibility and safety.

Church & Camp

- Be responsible for 5-10 campers each week of camp.
- Provide guidance, supervision and exemplary leadership for all campers and church members.
- Manage camper conflicts and discipline campers when necessary as per camp/church rules.
- Teach a skills class to campers based on your abilities and interests
- Assist with the drama or worship team.
- Lead activities for campers which include archery, fishing, boating, mountain biking, arts and crafts, large group games, swimming etc.
- Assist Activities/Ropes Staff with leading high ropes, zip line, and climbing wall.
- Participate enthusiastically in all activities with campers and church members.
- Lead a daily Bible study with your campers
- With each camper in your group, develop caring personal relationships and spend one-on-one time to understand their spiritual needs and find ways to help them on their journey
- Help clean the campsite/church along with other staff at the end of each week.

Accountability

- Be accountable to the Team Coordinator.
- Be accountable to camp directors who will supervise and review team members and report back to the Team Coordinator.
- Be accountable to church contact (i.e. Senior Pastor).

Qualifications

- Be a person who confesses Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and is demonstrating evidence of Christian growth and maturity.
- Have the desire to share and teach children about faith and Christ and seek opportunities to do so in a camp or church setting.
- Be willing to work hard and serve God through serving people.
- Be able to reflect Jesus Christ through your attitude, actions, and reactions.
- Have the ability to work well with others and be a positive role model

Job Description Summer Ministry Team 2012

- Have the ability to multi-task and be flexible in relation to camp conditions and situations.
- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Be willing to commit to the entire summer schedule (approx. mid May to end of August)
- Must attend or have previously attended an ECCC church.
- Must be physically fit and be able to sustain a servant attitude throughout the duration of the summer ministry team program.
- First Aid and CPR required for which training will be provided.
- Safe place training required for which training will be provided.
- Life Guard Certification preferred, but not required.
